Cellars (www.schradercellars.com) has produced some of the Napa Valley's finest wines. Fred Schrader, the winery's co-owner, is a cigar enthusiast, and for years he sought to combine his professional expertise for balancing sophisticated flavors and aromas with his passion for cigars. The result is Schrader Hispaniola cigars. They are manufactured by Para Ti, a small factory located just outside the city of Santiago in the Dominican Republic. Like his wines, Schrader's cigars will reflect their *terroir* from one vintage release to another. This fall's inaugural vintage consists of only 11,500 cigars, each of which is packaged in its own wood coffin.

RIEDEL BLACK TIE AMADEO DECANTER

Riedel (www.riedel.com) introduced the original, clear Amadeo decanter in 2006, the 250th anniversary of the Austrian company's founding and of fellow Austrian Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart's birthday. A year later, Riedel introduced the Black Amadeo. It has the same lyrelike shape, but it's made from black crystal, which is created by using manganese oxide to tint the glass in colors that vary from dark purple to pitch black. The latest Amadeo, the clear Black Tie, is distinguished by a single slender black stripe—created using manganese oxide—that follows the contours of the decanter. The Black Tie Amadeo is an ideal companion for Riedel's Sommeliers Black Tie glasses, which feature black stems and clear bases (for red wine) and clear stems and black bases (for white). With all of the Amadeo decanters, you decant wine into the vessel's wider opening and pour it into the glass through its slender mouth. All the Amadeo decanters are formed by hand without the use of molds.

DANIEL MARSHALL SOLID SILVER HUMIDOR

Daniel Marshall (www.danielmarshall.com) produced only 10 examples of this humidor, which is covered with 1 mm-thick solid sterling silver and numbered and signed by Marshall, who has a shop in Tustin, Calif., and has been making humidors since 1983 for such brands as Dunhill, Tiffany & Co., and S.T. Dupont. Marshall used 6.6 pounds of sterling silver to create this humidor, which can be viewed as an investment as much as an extravagance.
